SCORESHEETS

Weekly scoresheets are available to print from the Member Services site or APA phone app (league.poolplayers.com).

Blank scoresheets are available on the website (greaterseattle.apaleagues.com>League Materials). If you are preplaying matches, please contact the League Office to request preprinted scoresheets.

WHERE TO SEND SCORESHEETS

Scoresheets can be submitted electronically to scoresheets.gsapa@icloud.com. Please note your Team Number, Team Name, and Week of Play in the Subject line.

To be considered for bonus points they must be submitted **by midnight** the night after the completion of matches.

Email a scan or a CLEAR photo of your scoresheet. When sending a 9-Ball scoresheet you must send BOTH the front and the back pages. There are apps on your phone (iPhone Notes) or free apps that can be downloaded to your phone such as geniusscan, camscanner, scannable, turboscan, and others.

If you mail your scoresheets they must be POSTMARKED the day following the match to be considered on time. Please send them to:

MEMBERSHIP

Annual Membership Dues are \$25 and must be paid **BEFORE** playing a match. On the scoresheet, if a player's name does not have a dollar amount next to it this means that the player has paid their 2019 membership dues.

If a returning player shoots a match without paying their membership dues the team will lose **ALL POINTS** for that week for allowing an unpaid player to play.

New players being added to your roster must pay their membership dues **BEFORE** playing their first match. If an unpaid player shoots a match without submitting their fee the team will lose **ALL POINTS** for that week for allowing an unpaid player to play.

Encourage your players to pay online before the session starts.

PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS

Weekly team fees are \$40 (\$30 for Masters). The entire team fee is due regardless of the number of matches played (including forfeits). The entire team fee must be submitted at one time.

If submitted electronically the fee must be paid **by midnight** the night after the completion of your match to be considered on time. Please note your Team Number, Team Name, and Week of Play to which the payment applies. At this time we accept PayPal (Friends & Family), Zelle, SquareCash, and Venmo. Please use (425) 802-2403 as the 'Pay To' telephone number.

Checks should be made payable to Greater Seattle APA. If you send cash in the mail you do so at your own risk.



BONUS POINTS

Bonus points will be awarded as follows at the discretion of the League Office:



DIVISION REPRESENTATIVE

Your Division Representative is listed on the schedule and on the top of your scoresheet. Please contact him/her for questions about rulings and general matters on league night.

8-Ball: 3 points possible (1 point for ON TIME scoresheet, 1 point for ON TIME and correct payment, 1 point for complete scoresheet)

9-Ball: 10 points possible (3 points for ON TIME scoresheet, 2 points for ON TIME and correct payment, 5 points for complete scoresheet)

Masters: 3 points possible (1 point for ON TIME scoresheet, 1 point for ON TIME and correct payment, 1 point for complete scoresheet)
